

Duties, Responsibilities, & Expectations for Marching Warriors Student Leaders

1. Be one time (or early) to every rehearsal.
2. You must have at least one year of Marching Warriors Membership experience to apply.
3. Know your music and drill before anyone else in your section.
4. Be an EXCELLENT example and role model – musically and with your marching fundies.
5. Always have a positive attitude before, during & after rehearsals/performances – LEAVE YOUR BAGGAGE AT THE DOOR!
6. Remember that positive reinforcement is a much better tool than sarcasm or negativity.
7. Have a definite plan and goal(s) for each sectional and rehearsal.
8. Utilize effectively and efficiently your more experienced marchers when you need a little assistance.
9. Keep your section members “in the loop”. They should know at least the basics of your plan/goals.
10. There will be no “emergency” playing tests or drill tests. These should be on going throughout the season and planned well in advance.
11. Ideally, you are the only one to report good/bad news from your section to staff members, drum majors & Mr. Carroll.
12. DO NOT be the cause of drama and strife in your section. You need to be the peace keeper and voice of reason at all times.
