MATTHEW AGNEW

Matthew Agnew began studying Suzuki cello at age four. In High School he had the benefit of orchestra instruction and quidance from Shirley Mullins, a Janos Starker student, and cello instruction from Jane Katsuyama of the Dayton Philharmonic. He attended DePaul University on scholarship and studied with William Cernota from the Lyric Opera Orchestra.

Matthew is the principal cellist of the Elgin Symphony Orchestra, a position he has held since 2002. He has also served as principal cellist for dozens of Chicago Opera Theater performances. He frequently performs with the Chicago Philharmonic Orchestra as principal or assistant principal, and in 2005 he was awarded the assistant principal position with the Lancaster Festival Orchestra, a summer festival orchestra in Lancaster. Ohio, As a soloist, Matthew has been performing concertos since high school, when he premiered a cello concerto composed by his father at the Dayton Art Institute. Since then he has soloed often with the Elgin Symphony, including concertos by Haydn and Vivaldi, and the Crouching Tiger cello concerto by Tan Dun. He has conducted masterclasses for the Elgin Symphony, The New Music School, and North Park University. In 2020 he joined the Metropolis String Quartet, performing a unique mix of classical music, pop, and jazz in concerts all around Chicago. Matthew is the father of three boys, who keep him very busy when he is not playing the cello.



LACY GARBAR

Lacy Garbar, clarinetist, is a freelance performer and private studio teacher in the Chicago area. She earned a Bachelor of Music degree in Music Performance and Music Theory/Composition from Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, a Master of Music degree in Music Performance from Northwestern University, and a Performer's Certificate from Northern Illinois University. While at Northern Illinois University, Ms. Garbar was the



premiere winner of the annual concerto competition playing the Copland Clarinet Concerto. Ms. Garbar is currently a member of the New Philharmonic, and has performed with various Chicagoland ensembles including the Illinois Philharmonic Orchestra, Northwest Indiana Symphony Orchestra, South Bend Symphony Orchestra, Peoria Symphony Orchestra, Chamber Opera Chicago, and the Elmhurst Symphony. When not performing or teaching, this St. Louis native thoroughly enjoys her now hometown of Naperville with her husband and two young children, and continues to embark on her lifelong journey of learning the Russian language.



TAYLOROKEY

Taylor Okev is a New York City based actor, singer, educator, director, and producer. He was most recently seen on the first national tour of the Tony Award winning Broadway musical Bandstand, choreographed and directed by Hamilton's Andy Blakenbueller. He's appeared on stages across the country in shows like The Bridges of Madison County, Big Fish, Carousel, Altar Boyz!, and Hair, amona others.

As an educator, Taylor directed multiple theatrical productions, including Godspell, Beauty and the Beast, The Little Mermaid, The Music Man, Elf, and The Lion King. He frequently serves as a quest clinician and adjudicator for high schools across the country, focusing on healthy vocal techniques, storytelling through song, and audition preparation. As a private vocal and acting coach, Taylor currently coaches students across the country, both remotely and in person.

Taylor is also the co-founder of Snack Time Studios, a visual media based production company responsible for the creation of Second Act Snacks; a popular web series (streaming on Broadstream) that combines the worlds of food, theatre, and travel into one singular series, for which he serves as the co-creator, co-host, director, and producer.

He holds a BM in Music Education from Elmhurst University in Elmhurst, IL, and an MFA in Acting and Musical Theatre from The Boston Conservatory.


