Simple Symphony by Benjamin Britten

Benjamin Britten was an outstanding English composer who laid the foundation for the revival of English opera and also played an important role in the creation of a body of modern English songs. He was considered to be the most important English composer since Henry Purcell. Simple Symphony was written in 1934 and is based on material that he wrote between the ages of nine and twelve. His four movements are set in a chamber music format and contain many elements that are found in his later instrumental works such as tarantella-like themes and triple stopped open string chords. The titles that Britten created for each movement represent alliterations that tie into the characteristics of the music being performed.

Fugal compositions

At the Concert-level, we are focusing on the concept of the fugue in music. A fugue is when a short melody or phrase is presented in one part and then picked up and played in other instrument sections. You will hear this in English Fugue by Selby (CO), Psalm and Fugue by Hovhaness (CS), and the Mozart Symphony 41 finale (CS)

The 3 B's—Bach, Beethoven, and Brahms

At the Symphonic-level, we decided to focus this concert cycle on 3 of the great classical composers—Johann Sebastian Bach (Baroque), Ludwig van Beethoven (Classical), and Johannes Brahms (Romantic). We are taking the time to get to know these composers—their lives, their compositions, and their influence on music after them. Enjoy!

A note about Concert Strings 2020

The year was 2020, the date was March 13. The day before, the Wentz Hall concert (March 12, 2020) was canceled as the school district said no afternoon or events on or off campus could proceed because of a virus that was spreading. We came to school on Friday March 13 to see what would happen next. In period 7 Concert Strings, we were preparing our piece for the March 16 concert. By mid-day, the school district announced that school would be canceled for the next 2 weeks, up to Spring Break. Our concert was canceled!

We had prepared a fun piece called Serenade Triste. It was perfect for our group. We had strong basses—2 of them played the cello part for some extra challenge! The piece has a few different feelings to it, so we had a fun project to “Storyboard” the piece... each section worked together to create a story for each section of the piece. We were going to share our storyboards the day after the concert.

Of course, none of this came to pass. We didn't get to perform, we never shared our storyboards, and many of the students even kept the original parts of the music—still have them now. One of our members from that group, bass player Diane Rodriguez-Ruiz, passed away a year and a half later after a prolonged battle with blood cancer. And, the our beloved Mr. Burck, who taught these students technique, died a year and half later too. We decided to come back together to play Serenade Triste one last time. We're thankful to Isabela, Nathan, and Abby for coming out of “retirement” to pick their instruments up again and play with us. We're missing Jackie Zhang who went to IMSA her sophomore year.
