

MISSION IMPOSSIBLE: PROTOCOL

1. Do not drag anything, ever.
2. No talking on stage at all. Use hand signs.
3. Be Proactive: know what needs to happen. Be ready to move well in advance!
4. No food shall be on stage or in the house!
5. If you are not performing, you should be in the backstage wings at all times to assist with emergencies.
6. Although MI should be fun, it is not playtime. You are in charge of many thousands of dollars of equipment...please be respectful and do not screw around.
7. Do not touch the curtains. If the curtains are closed, touching them will cause them to split apart and allow the audience to see the stage (ruining the magic). Also, touching the curtains can damage them. If you should ever need to touch the curtains (for moving them) touch only the back.
8. Always double check and triple check your work.
9. Stay out of the way, if you are not helping you are hurting. Do not be on the stage longer than you need to, and make sure that you are not in the way of someone else.
10. Keep your instrument near headquarters. You may want to have your case also.
11. You should have a flashlight with blue gel. (we can gel flashlights if we need to the week of the concerts).
