The typical schedule involving music allows students to take all of the classes they need for college. Most students involved in music classes for four years maintain a grade point average well above 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. In the "capstone" ensembles (Varsity Singers, Chamber Strings, and Wind Ensemble) students maintain a grade point average of 3.5 or above. A recommendation from a music teacher can play a major part in a student's successful application to the four-year college or university of their choice regardless of their field of study. Waubonsie Valley students who study music throughout high school and pursue a degree in professions like medicine, business, engineering and education have a high level of acceptance into college. Similarly, Waubonsie Valley alumni pursuing music as a career have had a very high acceptance rate at the music school of their choice.
